## **Midnight brunch and pizza by the inch**

Want to feast on brunch in the middle of the night? Want to eat for nearly free? Here are some interesting goings-on in restaurants around town right now.

On April 17, Bubby's will start hosting a midnight brunch that features everything from a house-smoked salmon cream cheese scramble and blueberry sour cream pancakes to pork belly hash and taco platters. There's also a full bar menu with signature spicy bloody marys, organic shade grown coffee and other eye openers. The brunch will be held Tuesday through Sundays, from midnight to 7am. Bubby's is at 120 Hudson Street in Tribeca (212-219-0666).

On April 15, all seven Energy Kitchen locations around town will offer a free lunch with purchase of a beverage from noon to 2pm, and personal trainers from Crunch will work with the lunch crowds by hosting mini workouts and offering exercise tips. P.F. Chang's China Bistro will give guests a 15 percent discount on April 15 in honor of Tax Day.

Benihana's expanding its menu to offer a Twilight Tastings menu on Monday through Thursday during the first dinner hour. As part of the special, guests can choose two Benihana favorites, plus soup, salad, hibachi vegetables, veggie fried rice and green tea, for \$14.25 plus tax.

And today is Grand Opening Day at **Golosi**, a new pizza and gelato spot right by Grand Central that offers creamy fresh gelato and thin-crust pizzas. Golosi (it means glutton in Italian) sells pizza by the inch; they come in flavors like prosciutto di Parma. There are also 28 flavors of gelato, all made right here.
